MakerSphere Offers Woodworking Classes, Workshops & Shop Memberships

Woodworking Programs are in full swing at MakerSphere, giving community members the opportunity to learn woodworking skills as well as gain access to the shop space and tools. The shop has a full array of machines including table saw, drill press, planer, jointer, miter saw, belt and oscillating sanders, routers, band saws and plenty of hand tools.

CLASSES include a 7-week Beginner Woodworking Certification Course that teaches students how to use tools and machines safely. Students get hands-on experience throughout the class as they work on their projects. Students who complete the course are eligible to join the monthly membership program.

WORKSHOPS of varying length and skill level give community members the opportunity to explore specific skills, or to build a particular project such as a cutting board, side table, shelf, etc.

MONTHLY MEMBERSHIP is another option for those who need access to tools and the space to work on personal projects. Graduates of the 7 week certification course are eligible for membership. Others who have not taken the course and already have woodworking experience, will soon have a membership option as well, following an assessment process. This option will be available mid to late April.
