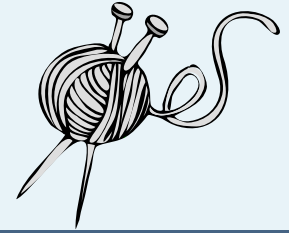


Sewing & Fiber Arts
