It's that time of year once again! Kids are headed back to school and MakerSphere art and making afterschool classes will be in full swing. The K-4 art classes are just about full, but middle school and high school programs remain open for registration. Check out these creative programs:

Clay - Grades 5 - 8

6 Fridays; Sept 11, 18, 25, Oct 2, 16, 23 (no class Oct 9)
4:00 pm - 6:00 pm at the clay studio. Fee: \$235.
Students will explore hand building techniques such as pinch, coil, and slab and will also be introduced to throwing on the wheel.

Beginner/Intermediate Sewing Grades 5 - 8

Tuesdays; October 6, 13, 20, 27, Nov 10, 17
4:00 pm - 6:00 pm at 30 Foundry Street, Waterbury
Fee: \$235 includes all materials/tools.
There is no limit to the range of sewing projects you can make when you learn to sew. In this course, students will make a variety of projects using the sewing machine and will learn foundational skills that will help them design and continue to create their own unique projects.

Beginner Woodworking Grades 9 - 12

7 Mondays; October 19, 26, Nov 2, 9, 16, 30, Dec 7
from 4:00 pm - 6:00 pm. Students take the bus from school to the shop. Course fee: \$285 includes all materials/supplies. This hands-on beginner woodworking course introduces high school students to the fundamentals of woodworking in a safe, supportive shop environment. Students will learn essential shop safety, planning, measuring, layout, and proper use of both hand and power tools, as they complete functional projects.

Stained Glass Grades 6 - 9

Learn all of the steps to create a stained glass piece from start to finish. Students will learn safety protocols, the techniques for cutting glass, copper foil tape application, and soldering. Students will create their first 6" square piece and take on more challenging projects as skills develop.
